This indenture made this 31st day of Dec in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty three between O. L. M. E. T. T. and M. H. Young of the County of Chattooga, State of Georgia and W. S. G. E. and J. S. Young of the County of Walker, State of Georgia also J S Young of the County of Walker State of Georgia guardian for F. A. and F. J. Young of the County of Chattooga State of Georgia, also G E Young of the county of Walker, State of Geo attorney for C W Young of the county of McLennan State of Texas said Youngs being of the first part and T McGhee of the County of Murray, State of Georgia of the second part[.] Witnesseth: That the said Youngs of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of sixteen hundred dollars in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained sold and conveyed unto the said T McGhee his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in the County of Murray, State of Georgia (9 dist) ninth dist and (3 sec) third sec. containing one hundred and twenty acres more or less of lot No 81 being all of said lot except forty acres on the North side of said lot sold to John Moore, and sixty acres more or less of lot No 82 being all of said lot except thirty acres on North side of said lot sold to John Moore, and except seventy acres off east side of said lot sold W. & H. R. Coffey and parcell of land known as the L. E. R. Young farm, containing one hundred and eighty acres more or less, together with all the rights and privileges hereunto belonging in fee simple And the said Youngs of the first part their heirs executors, guardians and administrators the titles to the [?] aforesaid will forever warrant and defend to the said T McGhee his heirs and assigns against the lawful claims of all such? persons In witness whereof the said Youngs of the first part hereunto set their hand and seal this 31st day of December 1883
