To all whom it may concern:—

Whereas, Philip Stay, late of the County of Camden and State of New Jersey, deceased, in and by his last will and testament in writing, did bequeath to his wife Catharine Stay, in addition to other property therein mentioned, the sum of One hundred dollars in Money to be paid to her on settlement of his personal Estate by his Executors herein named.

And whereas, the said Catharine Stay departed this life before receiving the said sum of One hundred dollars so bequeathed to her, whereby the same descended and became vested in her children and heirs at law, to wit; Daniel R. Stay, Joseph C. Stay, Samuel H. Stay, Sarah Bradock, wife of Asa Bradock, Mariah Burroughs, wife of Samuel H. Burroughs, Ann Bates wife of Eli Bates and Charles, John, Elyja, Aaron and James Stay and Sarah Ann Staffins wife of Richard C. Gafford children of James Stay deceased.

And whereas, the said heirs have by mutual agreement among themselves, resolved to appropriate so much of said Money as shall be required for the said purpose, to pay the funeral Expenses of the said Catharine Stay deceased and provide a erect Tomb Stones of a suitable size and quality to the graves of their said Philip and Catharine Stay deceased, out of a felicit regard to their memory; as well as for the payment of a claim by Dr. Jacob P. Hinnton the sum of Ten dollars for Medicine Attendance on the said Catharine Stay deceased and divide the residue of said Money (if any) pro rata among the several heirs above named; Ando that Jacob G. Rowand and Joseph C. Stay Executors of the said Philip Stay, dec'd. as well as Samuel H. Burroughs be authorized to apply said money as above provided.

of the agreement above set forth, do by these presents,
release, acquit and forever discharge the said Jacob
L. Rowana and Joseph C. Stay Executors of Philip
Stay dec^d. their respective heirs, Executors and ad-
ministrators of and from the said Legacy of One hundred
dollars (\$100) bequeathed to the said Catharine Stay
as aforesaid, and of and from all actions, suits,
payments, accounts, reckonings, claims and demands,
whatsoever, for or by reason thereof, or of any other-
ad, matter or thing touching the premises.
