To all whom it may concern:—

Whereas, Philip Stoy, late of the County of Camden and State of New Jersey, deceased, in and by his last will and testament in writing, did bequeath to his Wife Catharine Stoy, in addition to other property therein mentioned, the sum of One hundred dollars in Money to be paid to her on settlement of his personal Estate by his Executors therein named.

And whereas, the said Catharine Stoy departed this life before receiving the said sum of One hundred dollars so bequeathed to her, whereby the same decended and became vested in her children and heirs at law, to wit; Daniel B. Stoy, Joseph C. Stoy, Samuel H. Stoy, Sarah Braddock, wife of Asa Braddock, Mariah Burroughs, wife of Samuel H. Burroughs, Ann Bates wife of Eli Bates and Charles, John, Eliza, Aaron and James Stoy and Sarah Ann Stafford wife of Richard C. Stafford children of James Stoy deceased.

And whereas, the said heirs have by mutual agreement among themselves, resolved to appropriate so much of said Money as shall be required for the said purpose to pay the funeral Expenses of the said Catharine Stoy deceased and procure a erect Tomb Stone of a suitable size and quality to the graves of their said Philip and Catharine Stoy deceased, out of a felicit regard to their memory; as well as for the payment of a claim by Dr. Jacob B. Hinton the sum of Ten dollars for Medical Attendance on the said Catharine Stoy deceased and divide the residue of said Money (if any) pro. rata among the several heirs above named; And that just G. Rowland and Joseph C. Stoy Executors of the said Philip Stoy deceased as well as Samuel H. Burroughs be authorized to apply said Money as above provided

carry out the wishes of the heirs in manner aforesaid
Now therefore, we, Daniel R. Stoy, Sarah Ann Beaddock
Wife of Asa Beaddock, Joseph C. Stoy, Samuel R. Stoy,
Marien Burrough Wife of Samuel H. Burrough and
Ann Bates Wife of Eli Bates, Children and heirs at law
of Catharine Stoy deceased - Charles Stoy, Sarah Ann
Stafford, wife of Richard C. Stafford, John Stoy, Eliza
Stoy, James Stoy and Aaron Stoy grand children of the
said Catharine Stoy deceased, upon the fulfilment of
of the agreement above set forth, do by these presents,
release, acquit and forever discharge the said Jacob
G. Rowland and Joseph C. Stoy Executors of Philip
Stoy decd. their respective heirs, Executors and adm-
inistrators of and from the said Legacy of One hundred
dollars (\$100) bequeathed to the said Catharine Stoy
as aforesaid, and of and from all actions, suits,
payments, accounts, reckonings, claims and demands,
whatsoever, for or by reason thereof, or of any other
act, matter or thing touching the premises.

Eighteen hundred and fifty three.
