Adam Caylor's last Will and Testament

In the name of God Amen –

I, Adam Caylor of the County of Fayett being of sound mind and in good health and in my proper understanding do make Constitute and declare this instrument to be my last Will and Testament

First I Will my soul to Almighty good who gave it – second that my body be desently buried Third I give and bequeath to my beloved wife the use of the land ^I now^ live on for ten years also I will to my said wife all the personal property of any description that I now possess or may possess at the time of my death during her natural life and after her death I wish it particularly understood that I Will and bequeath what ever may be left of said property at my wife death to my ^two^ Daughters namely Amy Wright and Elizabeth Roluk[Robuck] to be equally divided between them at my wife desese

Personally appeared in open court Jacob Jamison one of the subscribing witnesses to the last Will and Testament of Adam Caylor late of Fayette County aforesaid dec<sup>d</sup> who being duly sworn deposes & says that the said Adam Caylor was at the time of signing said last Will and Testament of sound and disposing mind and memory, not under any apparent restraint, and over the age of twenty one years, and that he subscribed his name as witness to said Will in his presence and in the presence of Lewis Bocock the other subscribing witness to said Will (who has since removed to parts unknown) that he saw said Bocock also subscribe said Will and that affiant and Bocock each signed said Will in the presence of Adam Caylor and at his special request.
