In the name of god amen I John Rudd of Mecklenburg County being of weak body but in perfect sense and memory thanks be to god for the same, do give and bequeath my Estate as follows.

First I desire that all my just debts be payd and satisfied to my creditors after mentioned.

I give my Estate to my loving wife Sarah during her life or widowhood.

I give my Estate to my Three Children Namely Joseph Rud Nancy Rud and Wilmath Rudd to be Equally Divided Between to them and Their heirs forever ---. Also I desire M^r John Potter may Take my Rifel Gun and sell her to the best advantage and lastly I do nominate and my Loving friend John Potter and my Loving Father Joseph Rudd and my Loving Wife Sarah Rud to be my hole and sole executers of This my Last Will and Testament Revoking and Disannulling all other Will or Wills here unto made by me. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 28th day of April 1765
