FAMILY BIBLE RECORDS  
OF THE FAMILY OF  
WILLIAM WINGET & SARAH LINDLEY WINGET

This bible was originally the bible of William Winget who was born in 1827  
in Knox Co. Ohio. He was the son of William and Sarah Winget. Photocopies of  
the actual record in to be found with Jane Carpenter and/or Bruce Ogden.

It is now believed that William Winget who was born in 1790 was a son of  
Daniel Winget and Phebe Clutter early residents of Morris twp. Greene Co. Pa.  
Research is still ongoing to confirm this belief. William [1790] is first found  
in the 1812 Tax List for Greene Co. Pa., but the record is sketchy. In 1813 he  
is listed as being single, but the word single is crossed out, causing us to  
wonder if he was married during the later part of 1812 when the 1813 list was  
prepared. We find his name in tax lists and census records as late as 1820.  
About that time [1820] the family removed to Knox Co. Ohio and remained there  
until about 1836 when they again uprooted and went to Adams Co. Illinois where  
William Winget [1790] died in 1840. Sarah Lindley Winget, daughter of Israel  
Lindley and Ann, was born in 1795 in New Jersey and as a child of about 3 years  
of age removed with her parents from New Jersey to Washington Co. Pennsylvania.  
After the death of her husband William in 1840, Sarah Lindley Winget took her 2  
youngest children and went back to Knox Co. Ohio to be near her Lindley family  
who had remained in Knox Co. Ohio. About 1853 she returned to Adams Co. Illinois  
where she died in 1866.
