UNISON (UNION)

LOUDOUN COUNTY, VA.

Loudoun County, Va. - South Fork Cemetery, Unison (formerly Union) - Southwest of Unison about one mile on Route 630 - in field surrounded by a crumbling stone wall. A very old cemetery with a great many fieldstone markers head and foot, but those still readable were well-carved. The cemetery is uncared for now and overgrown. Over the years trees have fallen and broken and buried many of the stones.

The following is quoted from "Legends of Loudoun Valley" by Joseph V. Nichols - Pub. 1955 - Limited Edition 1961.

Early Quaker Settlers - "The records in the Clerk's office of Loudoun County show that Daniel Lovett and Sarah, his wife, by deed dated April 8, 1771, 'conveyed to Isaac Walker, and Solomon Divon as Trustees for the people called Quakers a certain tract or parcel of land situated on Beaver Dam fork of Goose Creek, containing ten acres.

Not long after this deed was executed a log meeting house was built on this lot and a burying ground laid out.

It is probable that meetings of Friends had been held in private dwellings in this vicinity for a number of years previous to the execution of the above deed for a minute of the Fairfax Meeting states, 'A meeting was established at South Fork 5th mo. 31, 1745.'

This meeting never had in its membership any minister but was supplied from Fairfax and Goose Creek. Owing to a decrease in membership and lack of attendance, services here were discontinued about 1890. A number of the writer's friends state that they attended services in the old meeting house a short time previous to that date. The old cemetery is still fairly well kept, but has been little used for the past 40 years.

This old Meeting house was located on the West side of the road now known as Quaker Lane about a mile South of Unison. All of the lot not heretofore disposed of except the burying ground was sold to Duncan Manuel April 1st, 1916. At that time the old meeting house was in ruins.

From the location of the above places of worship it may be fairly inferred that in the pre-revolutionary era fully half of that part of Loudoun Valley south of the 'German Settlement' was settled by members of the 'Society

of Friends.' Of these fully nine-tenths came from Pennsylvania and of the remainder most were from New Jersey with a few from Maryland.

There is no evidence that the established church of Virginia ever at any time interfered with the meetings for worship of any of the dissident religious organizations of Loudoun County.

In the Revolutionary War in this section the Friends suffered little and their conscientious convictions against war and military service were generally respected."
